Wednesday, June 12	8:40 – 12:00 Possibly 3:00 pm	English 30-1 Part A English 30-2 Part A	141 142 144	<p>All students that are writing diploma exams are to be in the exam room no later than 8:40 am. There is a considerable amount of setup time and instruction that needs to take place prior to the exam beginning.</p> <p>If the exam is scheduled to be written in three hours any student can elect to take up to six hours to write, without having to apply for accommodations. If the exam is designed to be written in two and a half hours any student can elect to take up to five hours.</p> <p>Seeing as students can be in the exam room for an extended period of time please encourage them to bring something to drink and something to eat.</p> <p>There is to be no personal technology in any exam, so please ensure you leave your personal devices in your locker or vehicle. However, students writing a mathematics diploma must bring an Alberta Education approved graphing calculator. Students writing a science diploma can bring any scientific calculator.</p> <p>For English and Social – Part A only – dictionaries and thesauruses will be provided in both English and multilingual upon student request.</p> <p>Grade 12 students will have a staggered completion. Last day of scheduled classes for a diploma subject course will be the day before a diploma exam. With the exception of diplomas that are after June 20, 2019, which is the final day for all scheduled classes. All option courses for grade 12 students will run until June 20, 2019.</p> <p>All diplomas must be written on the designated dates and times. If missed the student will need to wait till the next scheduled administration which will be in August 2019.</p> <p>Please note that teachers will be available for support up until a diploma is written. Simply make an appointment with the teacher.</p>

Regular Scheduled Classes**

Last day of scheduled classes for senior high is Thursday, June 20, 2019.

Final exams will begin on Friday, June 21, 2019.

The student semester 2 schedule will determine when and where the final is written. All finals are written in the same block and room as the scheduled class on the indicated date and time.

There are no finals administered for option courses.

Thursday, June 20, 2019 – will be the last day of scheduled classes for grades 10 to 12
