

2024 Jason Ewert Memorial Bursary

Applications are now open for the 2024 Jason Ewert Memorial Bursary, in remembrance of Jason Ewert, well known photographer and community member who passed away suddenly in late 2021. Jason's involvement in Three Hills and Kneehill County over the last number of years was far-reaching and his impact will be long remembered.

This Memorial Bursary for Post-Secondary education will recognize a graduate from Golden Hills School Division who has been involved in the Arts in some capacity during their highschool years, as well as exhibits qualities reminiscent of Jason. Through his long career as a photographer, leadership in his church, and community involvement through the Three Hills Arts Academy & other endeavours, Jason was well-known, loved and respected. He leaves a legacy of being a community builder, a team player, and someone who exhibited a joyful attitude with a servant heart to those around him.

Application - Please write a letter including the following:

- 1. Your name, School and Graduating year
- 2. A description of your involvement in the Arts in any of the various capacities through School, Community, or a Club. This can include a variety of artistic expressions including, but not limited to, Acting, Dance, Photography and/or Visual Art. (approx length: 1/2 to 1 full page)
- 3. Describe ways you have demonstrated qualities of leadership in seeking to build relationships within your school or community, being a team player, and exhibiting a joyful attitude and servant heart to those around you. (approx length: 1/2 to 1 full page)
- 4. Close your application with a description of what the Bursary would be used towards in your post-secondary pursuits. (approx length: 1/2 page)

In addition, include separately:

- 1. A one (1) page Reference letter from an adult/mentor from either your School, Community, or Club who can attest to the personal qualities you possess.
- 2. A short (max 1 page) Reference letter from a peer who has been involved with you in the Arts who can support the qualities described above in working alongside you.

Applications can be submitted between now and August 31st, 2024. The Bursary will be awarded by November 2024.
