

How to register for myBlueprint.ca

MyBluePrint will become an important part of planning for students at DVSS. All students will be registered on this site from grade 7 through to grade 12.

Students in grade 7 to 9 will focus primarily on:

- Assessments
- Goal Setting
- Resume and Cover Letter
- Portfolio and Reflection

Students in grade 10 to 12 will focus on:

- High School Planner
- Post Secondary Planner
- Occupation Planner
- Financial Planner
- Portfolio and Reflection

This will become an important part for students to map their way to an Alberta High School Diploma and transition planning when leaving high school.

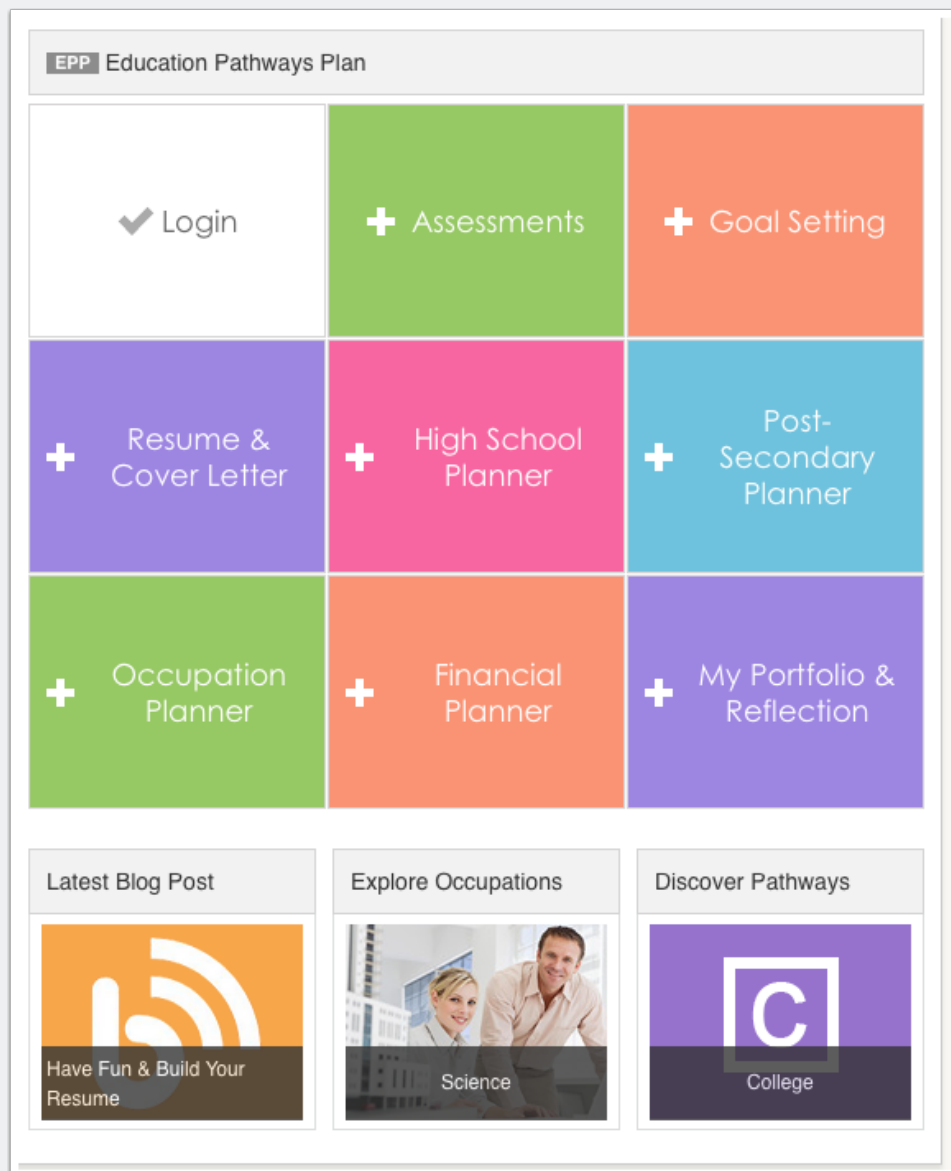

How do I link to my Teacher, Counsellor or Parent?

To link to a Teacher, Counsellor or Parent:

1. Click on the gear icon at the top of the page
2. Select **My Links**
3. Select user type you would like to add (**Teacher, Counsellor or Parent**)
4. For Teachers and Counsellors, Click **Send Request** next to name of user

Note: To link to a parent, you will need to know your parent's email address to send a link request.
