Tips & Tricks

- ★ Designate a folder to store your scholarship information.
- ★ Prepare and collect the following:
 - a. Write ONE Essay Template
 - *Make copies of it and tweak them for different scholarships to highlight what the committee wants to know.*
 - *Respect if they have a word count!*
 - *Need Help? See our "Scholarship Essay Help Page"*
 - b. Collect two or three reference letters now.
 - One Educational & one Community
 - c. Post-secondary conditional acceptance letters.
 - d. Up To date Detailed Academic Report.
 - e. Some applications will require family Tax Forms (Canada Revenue Notice of Assessments).
- ★ Mark deadlines in your calendar!
- ★ Read the application carefully and thoroughly!
